ADHERES TO THE ACADEMIC CALENDAR : ACTION TAKEN REPORT

The Department of History adheres to the Academic Calendar prepared by the Academic calendar committee. Academic calendars have been uploaded in the Institutional website. The Academic calendar includes online admission, time table, orientation programmes after admission, the dates of commencement and completion of syllabus, schedules of class test, remedial classes for Advance and slow learners, total practical classes of science stream, assignment collection, tour and submission of project report(Education, History, Geography, and Sociology), proposed seminars, list of co-curricular activities or outreach programmes, celebration of important days, and instruction for preparation of Class Diary for teachers etc. Faculty members prepare class routine, teaching plans, participate or conduct co-curricular activities, and Class Diary according to the Academic calendar. Every teacher completes syllabus and conducts class test, student seminar, and internal assessments.

All efforts are made by the Department of History to adhere to the Academic calendar. We admit that we failed to conduct many academic activities during the pandemic, but we tried our best to serve students for their progression. Regular departmental meetings are held to assess the progress of the syllabus coverage of each teacher. The syllabus is distributed among faculty members in departmental meetings and the detail teaching plan is uploaded in the Departmental tab of the college website, which stakeholders can access. Continuous and a systematic evaluation process is used to assess the learning levels of the students. This evaluation process consists of written examination, class test, open book test, group discussion, presentation, student seminar, tour, submission of project report, practical examination with viva, and submission of assignment. For Slow learners special classes and class test are conducted. Slow learners take the advantage of tutorial classes conducted by the faculty for

one to one interaction. Faculty members conduct extra classes for slow learners after the class hours, in some cases after 3 P.M. Online special classes are held from 4.8.2020 to 25.8.2020. Faculty members shared study materials during the pandemic through gmail or whatsapp group. Special programs for advance learners: a. Tutorial examinations are conducted; b. Learning needs of the advance student are further fulfilled by different activities. Advance learners also attend Workshops/ Seminars/ Symposiums to keep them updated on various advancements. C. Advanced students can access INFLIBNET through faculty members' assistance. Teachers prepare grade sheet to assess learning level of the students.
