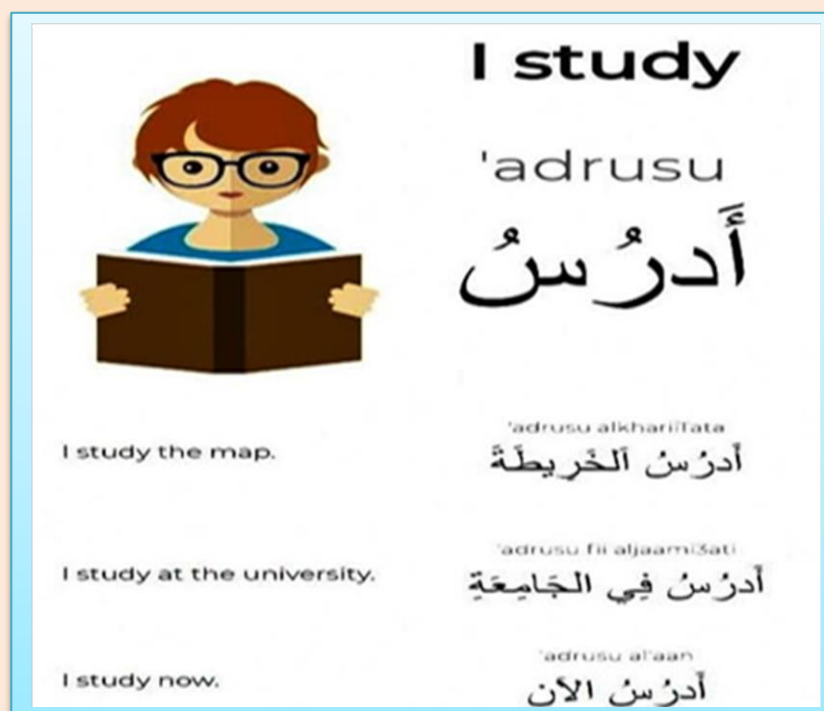

### 2.3. Teaching- Learning Process:

2.3.1. Student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies are used for enhancing learning experiences.

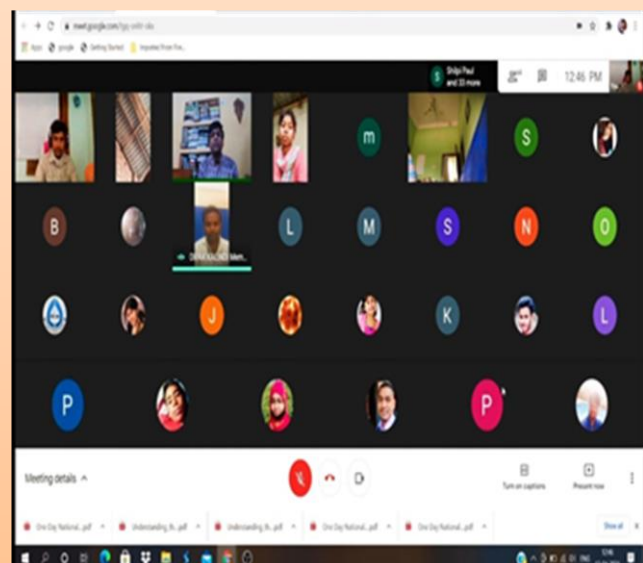

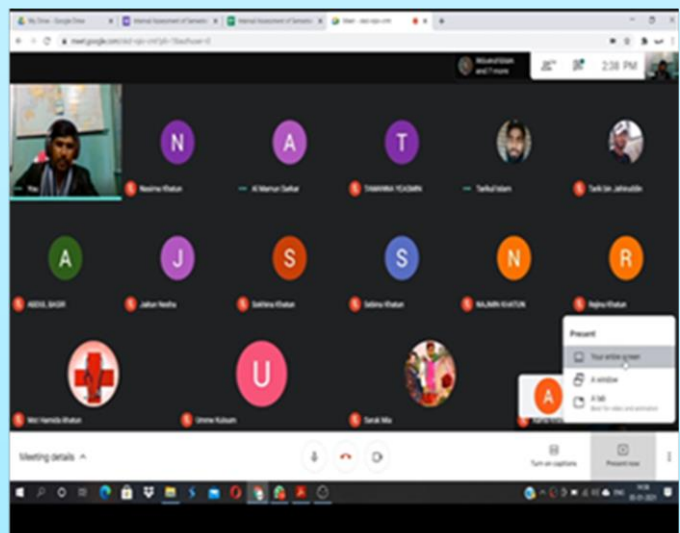
**How to write Seminar Paper:**

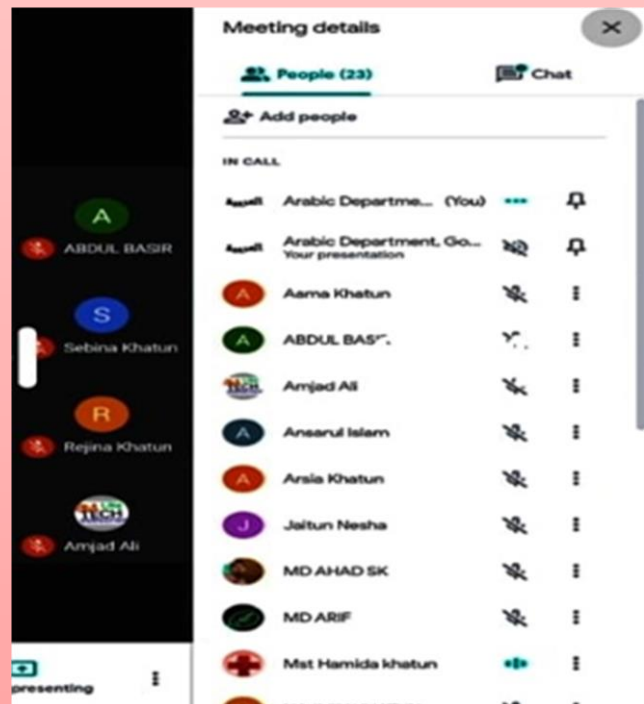

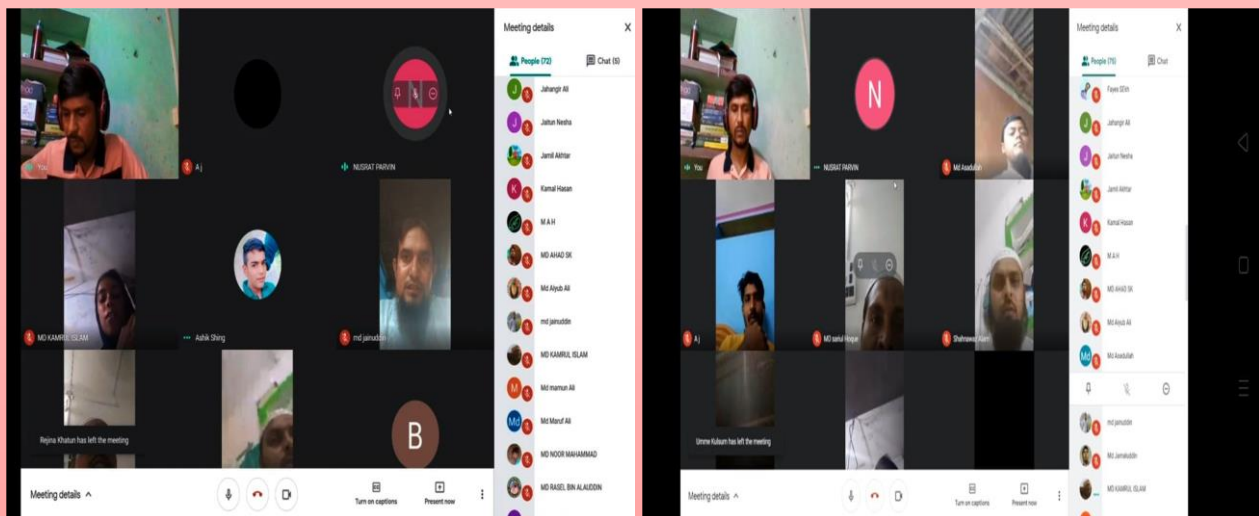

**4. Problem solving Methods:** 19 Departments provide students tasks that inculcate in them problem solving skills. The Arabic department organized a program on related topics.

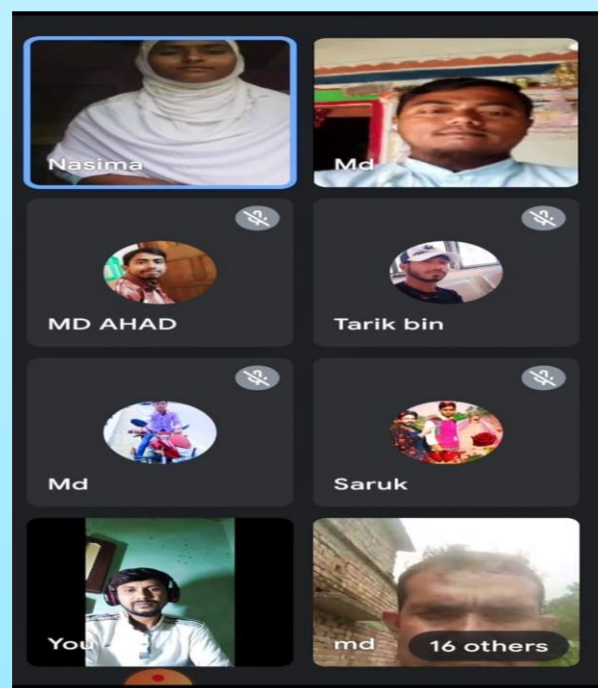
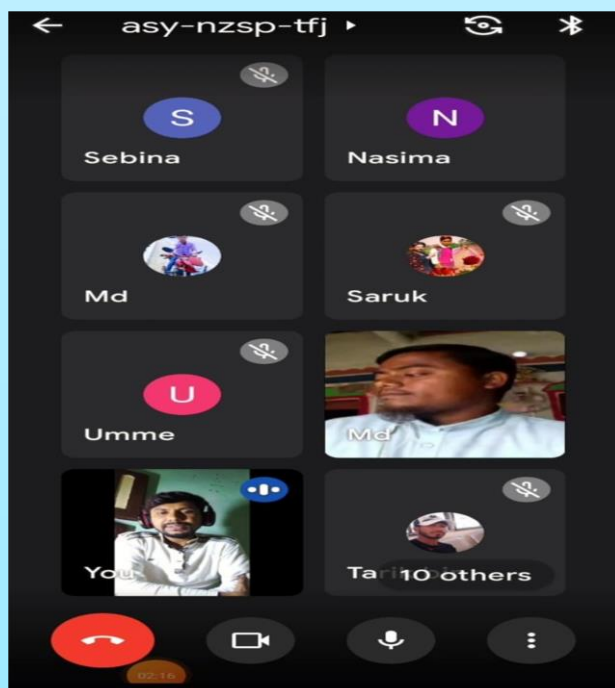
