Response: Gour Mahavidyalaya, Malda, has the vision of a society based on love, freedom, liberty, justice, equality and fraternity. Many topics of the Curriculum are designed by the Board of Studies, the University of Gour Banga, Malda, with an utmost effort to instil sensitivity among students about freedom, liberty, unity, harmony, tolerance, justice, equality and fraternity in the courses like History (DC-II- Buddhism, Non- violence, Asokan Dhamma-tolerance, DC-9- Swadeshi Movement, Gandhiji- Non-Violence; DC-12-French Revolution- liberty, equality and fraternity); Bengali (DSE-2B), English (DSE 2A/2B), Sanskrit(Semester-IV-C-8); and Sociology (DC-I). More than 3000 poor students are benefitted by scholarships, half -free or full -free. Students from marginalised sections of the society, in terms of caste, class, gender and religion, are offered remedial coachings. There is a myriad of opportunities for the students to participate in co-curricular activities. Rakhi Bandhan is celebrated every year in college where the students have an opportunity to strengthen their ties with the friends. The College celebrates National and International commemorative days. Periodic seminars, workshops, special lectures, reunions are held keeping in
